### THE MUNICIPAL POLICY FOR COVID-19 OPERATION

1. The office will be closed to the public, but we will do business by phone, our number is 306-336-2244 and by e-mail, our address is [rm.217@sasktel.net](mailto:rm.217@sasktel.net)
2. Should you wish to speak to a Councillor regarding an issue that may come up, you may call the office and we will forward your information to the Councillor, or you may contact your Councillor directly. Once you have discussed the issue with the Councillor by phone, further action may be taken, such as internet contact, if personal contact is required, it is the choice of the Councillor, but please note social distancing will be practiced.
3. Grader Operators have been instructed to have any taxpayer call the office should they have a concern or wish some additional grading of a driveway. They are not to meet with taxpayers during working hours, again, social distancing is of high importance, and we do have a responsibility to our employees.
