Bylaw # 2012-09

A Bylaw to regulate the speed of vehicles on the road commonly known as the Freeland Grid

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Lipton #217 In the Province of Saskatchewan enacts the

1. Definitions:

- a. "highway" means a road, parkway, driveway, square or place designated for or used by the seneral public for the passage of vehicles, but does not include any area, whether privately republicly owned, that is primarily intended to be used for the parking of vehicles and the eccessary passageways on that area; as defined in the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1.
- b. Imotor vehicle" means a vehicle propelled or driven by any means other than muscular power; as defined in the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-18.1.
- 2. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than seventy kilometers (70 km) per hour on the highway known as the Freeland road and located North of sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 township 23 range 15 west of the second meridian, North of sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 township 23 range 14 west of the second meridian and North of sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36 township 23 range 13 west of the second meridian.
- 3. No person shall operate a motor vehicle at a speed greater than seventy kilometers (70 km) per hour on the highway known as the Strasbourg Grid and located North of sections 19,20,21,22,23 and 24 township 24 range 15 west of the second meridian, North of sections 19,20,21,22,23 and 24 township 24 range 14 west of the second meridian and North of sections 19,20,21,22,23 and 24 township 24 range 13 west of the second meridian.
- Signs indicating the maximum speed allowed shall be erected at the commencement of the speed zone area and signs shall be erected showing the end of the speed zone area.

5. This bylaw shall coming into force upon and take effect on the day of final passing.
