- a. Municipal Revenue Sharing Grant Declaration of Eligibility 2020-21. A Council resolution is required confirming certain actions have been met, compliance questionnaire is attached.
- 2021 Insurance requirement through SARM Liability, Property and equipment, bonding and benefit plans for employees, STD, LTD, Health benefits. In reviewing the insurance Council has adjusted the insured amounts for buildings in 2020, and has increased the Municipality's liability which is \$2 million above the standard \$3 million. Council may wish to consider increasing the insurance payable on the rental of equipment, presently under the policy we carry the standard \$2,500. The premium is \$10 per \$1,000 to a maximum of \$20,000.
- b. The Calling Lakes Cruisers Snowmobile Club is seeking Council's approval to use the road allowance east of Section 1 & 12-22-14-W2 as part of their trail system. If I recall correctly there was an issue with the adjoining landowner seeking approval for a fence across the road for a temporary closing for cattle watering, unless I have the wrong location and it's a mile to the east.
